



Since we are now into spring sports, I will focus on the track teams. Coach Leo GrosJacques motivated the participants to ten Capitol Conference Championships. The records were set in 1958 through 1969, when Serra was closed. The record board which was located in the hallway and viewed by all students has been sadly lost. I have recreated it as follows.

Afterwards, those attending had an opportunity to watch Blanchet's varsity boys basketball team play Harrisburg. It was a pleasure to see Mel Counts' grandsons lead Blanchet to the win! The LASC receives President's Award

Blanchet celebrated Founders Day on February 23, an annual event to recognize individuals and groups who have made a significant impact on their school.

During the ceremony, Development Director Brandy O'Bannon announced that the recipient of the 2012 President's Award was the Legacy Alumni Committee! The award is one of the school's highest honors and recognizes individuals and groups that have made significant contributions to the school's success. Below are excerpts from Brandy's remarks at Founders Day:

Several years ago, a Legacy Alumni Committee was formed with the mission to help facilitate the connection among students and graduates of Salem's Catholic high schools through projects and events. To that

purpose, the Committee's accomplishments are significant. They have:

- Organized two all school, all year reunions at Blanchet. The most recent, "The Gathering," in August 2011 brought 500 alumni to our campus;
- Coordinated a quarterly newsletter that is mailed to over 2,000 alumni throughout the country;
- Maintained an active database and helped facilitate dozens of class reunions;
- Hosted at least two alumni socials annually connected with Blanchet athletic and drama activities;
- Raised funds and installed a trophy case in Blanchet's lobby that showcases memorabilia from Serra and Sacred Heart as well as created an archive of materials from both schools.

All alumni will be invited to a dedication event for the new building – anticipated for late August or early summer – stay tuned for more information!

Blanchet Catholic School is looking forward to breaking ground on a new 10,600 sq. ft. Commons building in April. This new addition will feature a student cafeteria, commercial kitchen and athletic locker rooms, and a landscaped courtyard. The new building should be complete this September, the beginning of their 18th school year.

The Commons will meet many important needs on campus, since the school currently does not have a cafeteria (students eat in the gym) and its current kitchen is very small and outdated. In addition to serving as a wonderful gathering place for students, staff and Blanchet families, the Commons will also be available to outside groups for events. Blanchet

is generously offering use of its Commons (depending on availability) for Sacred Heart and Serra Catholic alumni to hold reunions and class gatherings at no charge! Contact Brandy O'Bannon for more information and to schedule your event.

The Commons is a \$1.7 million dollar project that is included in Blanchet's \$4.3 million "Foundation for the Future" comprehensive fundraising campaign. The campaign's goal is to fund the most urgent needs of the school's strategic five-year plan which include: providing tuition assistance, enhancing the curriculum, upgrading technology and building and renovating facilities. To date, the school has secured pledges of \$3.5 million towards its goal.
